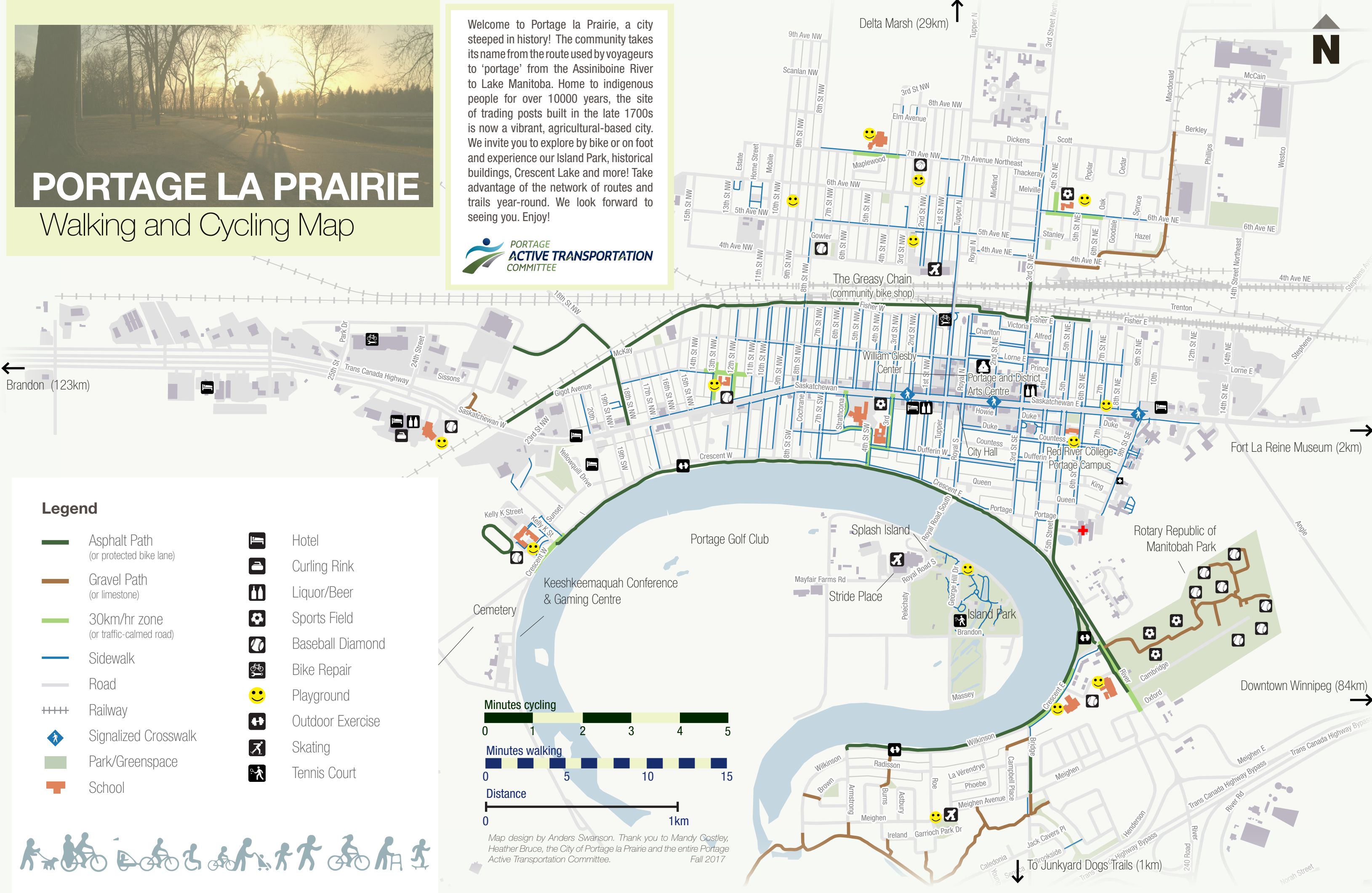




# PORTAGE LA PRAIRIE

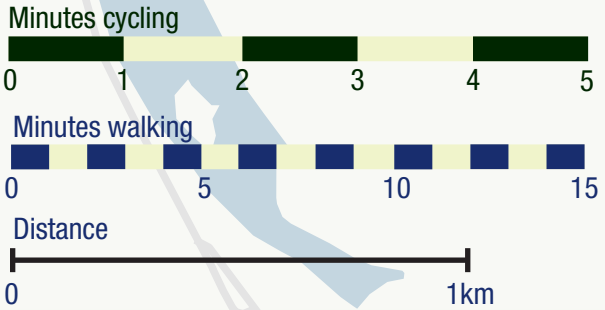
## Walking and Cycling Map
